## ABSTRACT

The abstract may vary between 150 and 300 words and should be presented in Spanish/Catalan and English (in case of papers written in English, just write the abstract in English). The content of the abstract must include which aspects you will discuss in your paper, including the introduction, objectives, methodology and results. For the abstract, use Arial 9 without using underline or bold, with full justification and single spacing.

## MAIN BODY

For the body, use Arial 10 without using underline or bold (will only be used headings and titles of tables and figures), with full justification and single spacing.

The text will be divided into logical sections, with descriptive headings, numbered at different levels, in bold (first and second level) and italics (third level):

### 1. FIRST LEVEL HEADING

#### 1.1. Second level heading

##### 1.1.1. Third level heading

Paragraphs will begin without tabulation and with single spacing with regard to the title or the prior paragraph.

The tables should be included in the same page of the text where they are quoted. If the table is too big, a single page immediately after the page where it was quoted will be used. In the text, we will refer to them as Table 1, Table 2... Each table will have at the bottom its number and title, and the source of data will be specified. If they were produced by the author "Own elaboration", "Prepared by the author" or similar will be recorded as a source.

Graphics, maps, diagrams, pictures... will be considered as figures.

Figures will be included in the same page of the text where they are quoted. If the figure is too big, a single page immediately after the page where it was quoted will be used. Each figure will have at the bottom its number and title, and the source of data will be specified. If they were produced by the author "Own elaboration", "Prepared by the author" or similar will be recorded as a source.

A reference list, in alphabetical order by author, should be included at the end of the manuscript. The content and format of each reference in this list should be in concordance with the APA standard and according to the following examples:

**Other instructions:**

- The text must be written in an electronic format compatible with Microsoft Word and DIN-A4 size. Margins should be as follows: left 3 cm, right, top and bottom 2.5 cm.
- Tables and Figures should be in JPG or TIFF format with a minimum resolution of 300 dpi.
- The article (including title, main text, notes, graphs, tables, figures, maps and bibliographic references) should not exceed 12 pages. Illustrations of the texts must be submitted in digital format, with a resolution high enough to guarantee their reproduction quality (minimum 300 dpi), preferably in JPEG or TIFF formats. The illustrations cannot be more than 3 pages long.
- The article should preferably be of the following structure: Introduction / Objectives / Methodology/ Results discussion/ Conclusions / References.
- All pages should be numbered, starting with the cover page as page 1.
- Footnotes should be avoided and its information should be included in the text.
